### Rashi Highlights & D'verei HaTorah

**Bamidbar/Numbers 33:3.** And they departed from Rameses in the first month, on the fifteenth day of the first month; on the next day after the Passover the children of Israel went out with a high hand in the sight of all the Egyptians. [*Ohr L'Goyim*]

**Bamidbar/Numbers 33:55.** But if you will not drive out the inhabitants of the land from before you; then it shall come to pass, that *those whom you allow to remain of them shall be pricks in your eyes, and thorns in your sides, and shall harass you in the land where you live.* 56. Moreover it shall come to pass, that *I shall do to you, as I thought to do to them.*

--Rashi, Bamidbar 33:55 -- those whom you leave over They will be a source of misfortune for you. as spikes in your eyes Heb. לְשָׁפִים, pins that will gouge out your eyes. The Targum [Onkelos renders], תְּדוֹת (Exod. 38:20), pins or spikes [as] סְפִיָּא - and thorns Heb. וְלְצִינִים. The commentators interpret this in the sense of a hedge of thorns which will surround you, fencing you in and confining you so that none can leave or enter. - and they will harass you Heb. וְצָרְרוּ, as the Targum [Onkelos] renders [ויעיקון], and they will harass you, cause you distress].

**Yechezkel/Ezekiel 20:35.** And *I will bring you into the wilderness of the people*, and *there will I remonstrate with you face to face.*

**Bamidbar 33:1.** These are the *journeys* (יְסוּדֵי) of the people of Israel, which went forth out of the land of Egypt with their armies under the hand of Moses and Aaron.

**Bamidbar/Numbers 35:25.** And the congregation shall deliver the slayer from the hand of the avenger of blood, and the congregation shall restore him to his city of refuge, where he had fled; and he shall live there until the death of the high priest, who was anointed with the holy oil.

--**Rashi, Bamidbar 35:25 -- until the kohen gadol... dies** For he causes the Divine Presence to rest upon Israel and thus prolong their lives, whereas the murderer causes the Divine Presence to withdraw from Israel and thus shorten their lives. He is not worthy of standing before the *Kohen Gadol* [*Sifrei Massei* 20].

**Another interpretation: Because the Kohen Gadol should have prayed that such a misfortune should not befall Israel during his lifetime [Mak. 11a]. who anointed him with the sacred oil** According to the literal meaning, this is one of the elliptical verses [in Scripture], as it does not reveal who anointed him; thus, it is like saying, "who was anointed by the one who anointed him with the sacred oil." Our Rabbis expounded it in Tractate *Makkoth* (11b) as a verification of the law, to teach that if before sentence was passed, the *Kohen Gadol* died and they appointed another one in his stead, and afterwards sentence was passed, he [the murderer] can return home only after the second one has died, as it says, "who anointed him." Did he anoint the *kohen*, or did the *kohen* anoint him? However, this includes the [case of a high *kohen* who was] anointed in his days [and thus, it is as if he had anointed the *Kohen Gadol*, so to speak], that he frees him through his death.

Then you shall drive out all the inhabitants of the land from before you, and destroy all their figured pavements, and destroy all their molten images, and devastate all their high places; 53. Then the Negev quarter shall be from the wilderness of Zin along by the border of Edom, and your south border shall be the end of the Sea of Salt on the east; 4. And the cities which you shall give shall be six cities for refuge. 14. You shall give three cities in this side of the Jordan, and three cities you shall give in the land of Canaan. Or if he hits him with a weapon of wood in his hand, whereby he may die, and he dies, he is a murderer; the murderer shall surely be put to death. 19. The avenger of blood shall himself slay the murderer; when he meets him, he shall slay

**Targum Judaica, Bamidbar/Numbers 35:22.** But if he stabbed him suddenly without enmity, or hurled upon him anything without lying in wait; 23. Or with any stone, whereby a man may die, without seeing him, and cast upon him, that he died, and he was not his enemy, nor sought his harm; 24. Then the congregation shall judge between the man slayer and the avenger of blood, according to these judgments. 25. And the congregation shall deliver the slayer from the hand of the avenger of blood, and the congregation shall restore him to his city of refuge, where he had fled; and he shall live there until the death of the high priest, who was anointed with the holy oil. 26. **Targum Judaica, Bamidbar/Numbers 35:31.** Moreover, you shall take no ransom for the life of a murderer, who is guilty of death, but he shall surely be put to death. 32. Because he must remain in his city of refuge, until the death of the high priest; but after the death of the high priest the man slayer may return to the land of his possession.

--**Rashi, Shemos/Exodus 40:38** For the cloud of the LORD was upon the tabernacle by day, and there was fire therein by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel, throughout all their journeys. -

--**Fourteen (14) in the first year**

--**Eight (8) after the death of Aaron** (in the last year)

-- = **Tewnty (20) journeys in thirty-eight years**

**Bamidbar/Numbers 33:18** And they journeyed from Hazereth, and pitched in Rithmah.

--**Tehillim/Psalm 120:3** What shall be given unto thee, and what shall be done more unto thee, thou deceitful tongue? 4 Sharp arrows of the mighty, with coals of broom.

--**Bereshis Rabbah 98:19** -- THEY HAVE DEALT BITTERLY WITH HIM (XLIX, 23). A son who made his brothers suffer, a son whom his brothers made to suffer, a son who made his mistress suffer, a son whom his mistress made to suffer. But I do not know who caused more suffering. Therefore it says, AND THEY EXCEEDED.7 AND THE ARCHERS (BA'ALE HIZIM) HATED HIM. This alludes to his camp-fellows (ba'ale mekizah).8 [Also, *to those*] who cast at him words cruel as an arrow (hez)9: Sharp arrows of the mighty (Ps. CXX, 4). Why does he compare them to an arrow rather than to any other weapon? All other weapons smite from close quarters, whereas this smites from the distance. Even so is slander, for it is spoken in Rome and kills in Syria. Nor is it like any other coals, but like Coals of broom (ib.). For all other coals are extinguished inside [when they are extinguished on the outside], but coals of broom are still burning within when they are extinguished without. So is *he who listens to slander: even if you go and appease him and he lets himself be appeased, yet he is still burning within.*1 It once happened that a broom tree was set on fire and it burned eighteen months: winter, summer and winter.

**Bamidbar/Numbers 35:17** And if he smote him with a stone in the hand, whereby a man may die, and he died, he is a murderer; the murderer shall surely be put to death.

--**Shemos/Exodus 21:18** And if men contend, and one smite the other with a stone, or with his fist, and he die not, but keep his bed; 19 if he rise again, and walk abroad upon his staff, then shall he that smote him be quit; only he shall pay for the loss of his time, and shall cause him to be thoroughly healed.

**--Zechariah 8:22** Yea, *many peoples* and *mighty nations* shall come to seek the LORD of hosts in Jerusalem, and to entreat the favour of the LORD. 23 Thus saith the LORD of hosts: In those days it shall come to pass, that *ten men shall take hold, out of all the languages of the nations, shall even take hold of the skirt of him that is a Jew,* saying: We will go with you, for we have *heard that God is with you.*'

**Bamidbar/Numbers 33:50** And the LORD spoke unto Moses in the plains of Moab by the Jordan at Jericho, saying: 51 'Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them: **When ye pass over the Jordan into the land of Canaan,** 52 **then ye shall drive out all the inhabitants of the land from before you, and destroy all their figured stones, and destroy all their molten images, and demolish all their high places.** 53 And ye shall drive out the inhabitants of the land, and dwell therein; **for unto you** have I given the land to possess it. 54 And ye shall inherit the land by lot according to your families - to the more ye shall give the more inheritance, and to the fewer thou shalt give the less inheritance; wheresoever the lot falleth to any man, that shall be his; *according to the tribes of your fathers* shall ye inherit. 55 But if ye will not drive out the inhabitants of the land from before you, then shall those that ye let remain of them be *as thorns in your eyes, and as pricks in your sides,* and they shall harass you in the land wherein ye dwell. 56 And it shall come to pass, that *as I thought* to do unto them, so will I do unto you.

**Bamidbar/Numbers 35:9** And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying: 10 'Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them: When ye pass over the Jordan into the land of Canaan, 11 then ye shall appoint you cities to be **cities of refuge** for you, that the manslayer that killeth any person through error may flee thither. 12 And the cities shall be unto you for refuge from the avenger, that the manslayer die not, until he stand before the congregation for judgment. 13 And as to the cities which ye shall give, there shall be for you six cities of refuge. 14 Ye shall give **three cities beyond the Jordan,** and **three cities shall ye give in the land of Canaan;** they shall be cities of refuge. 15 For the children of Israel, and for the stranger and for the settler among them, shall these six cities be for refuge, that every one that killeth any person through error may flee thither.

**Bamidbar/Numbers 35:16** But ***if he smote him with an instrument of iron, so that he died, he is a murderer; the murderer shall surely be put to death.*** 17 And if he smote him with a stone in the hand, whereby a man may die, and he died, he is a murderer; the murderer shall surely be put to death. 18 Or if he smote him with a weapon of wood in the hand, whereby a man may die, and he died, he is a murderer; the murderer shall surely be put to death. 19 **The avenger of blood shall himself put the murderer to death; when he meeteth him, he shall put him to death.** 20 And if he thrust him **of hatred,** or hurled at him any thing, lying in wait, so that he died; 21 or in enmity smote him with his hand, that he died; he that smote

him shall surely be put to death: he is a murderer; ***the avenger of blood shall put the murderer to death when he meeteth him.***

***Bamidbar/Numbers 35:22*** But ***if he thrust him suddenly without enmity,*** or hurled upon him any thing ***without lying in wait,*** 23 or with any stone, whereby a man may die, seeing him not, and cast it upon him, so that he died, and ***he was not his enemy, neither sought his harm;*** 24 then the congregation shall judge between the smiter and the avenger of blood according to these ordinances; 25 and ***the congregation shall deliver the manslayer out of the hand of the avenger of blood, and the congregation shall restore him to his city of refuge, whither he was fled; and he shall dwell therein until the death of the high priest, who was anointed with the holy oil.*** 26 But if the manslayer shall at any time go beyond the border of his city of refuge, whither he fleeth; 27 and the avenger of blood find him without the border of his city of refuge, and the avenger of blood slay the manslayer; there shall be no bloodguiltiness for him; 28 because ***he must remain in his city of refuge until the death of the high priest; but after the death of the high priest the manslayer may return into the land of his possession.***

***Bamidbar/Numbers 35:29*** And these things shall be for a statute of judgment unto you throughout your generations in all your dwellings. 30 Whoso killeth any person, the murderer shall be ***slain at the mouth of witnesses;*** but one witness shall not testify against any person that he die.

***Bamidbar/Numbers 35:31*** Moreover ***ye shall take no ransom for the life of a murderer, that is guilty of death; but he shall surely be put to death.*** 32 And ye shall take no ransom for him that is fled to his city of refuge, that he should come again to dwell in the land, until the death of the priest.

19. And they departed from Rithmah, and camped at Rimmon-Perez.
20. And they departed from Rimmon-Perez, and camped in Libnah.
21. And they moved from Libnah, and camped at Rissah.
22. And they journeyed from Rissah, and camped in Kehelathah.
23. And they went from Kehelathah, and camped in Mount Shapher.
24. And they moved from Mount Shapher, and camped in Haradah.

50. And the Lord spoke to Moses in the plains of Moab by the Jordan near Jericho, saying,
51. Speak to the people of Israel, and say to them, When you have passed over the Jordan into the land of Canaan;
52. Then you shall drive out all the inhabitants of the land from before you, and destroy all their figured pavements, and destroy all their molten images, and devastate all their high places;
53. And you shall dispossess the inhabitants of the land, and live in it; for I have given you the land to possess it.
54. And you shall divide the land by lot for an inheritance among your families; and to the more you shall give more inheritance, and to the fewer you shall give less inheritance; every man's inheritance shall be in the place where his lot falls; according to the tribes of your fathers you shall inherit.
55. But if you will not drive out the inhabitants of the land from before you; then it shall come to pass, that those whom you allow to remain of them shall be pricks in your eyes, and thorns in your sides, and shall harass you in the land where you live.
56. Moreover it shall come to pass, that I shall do to you, as I thought to do to them.

**Tanach - Numbers Chapter 34**

7. And this shall be your north border; from the Great Sea you mark your line to Mount Hor;
8. From Mount Hor you shall mark your line to the entrance of Hamath; and the limits of the border shall be to Zedad;
9. And the border shall go on to Ziphron, and its limits shall be at Hazar-Enan; this shall be your north border.
10. And you shall point out your east border from Hazar-Enan to Shepham;
11. And the border shall go down from Shepham to Riblah, on the east side of Ain; and the border shall descend, and shall reach the side of the sea of Kinnereth eastward;
12. And the border shall go down to the Jordan, and its limits shall be at the Sea of Salt; this shall be your land with its borders around.
13. And Moses commanded the people of Israel, saying, This is the land which you shall inherit by lot, which the Lord commanded to give to the nine tribes, and to the half tribe;
14. For the tribe of the sons of Reuben according to the house of their fathers, and the tribe of the sons of Gad according to the house of their fathers, have received their inheritance; and half the tribe of Manasseh have received their inheritance;
15. The two tribes and the half tribe have received their inheritance on this side of the Jordan near Jericho eastward, toward the sunrise.
16. And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying,
17. These are the names of the men which shall divide the land to you; Eleazar the priest, and Joshua the son of Nun.
18. And you shall take one prince of every tribe, to divide the land by inheritance.
19. And the names of the men are these; From the tribe of Judah, Caleb the son of Jephunneh.

**Bamidbar 33:1.** These are the *journeys* (יְסוּדֹתַי) of the people of Israel, which went forth out of the land of Egypt with their armies under the hand of Moses and Aaron.

20. And from the tribe of the sons of Simeon, Samuel the son of Ammihud.
21. From the tribe of Benjamin, Elidad the son of Kislou.
22. And the prince of the tribe of the sons of Dan, Bukki the son of Jogli.
23. The prince of the sons of Joseph, for the tribe of the sons of Manasseh, Hanniel the son of Ephod.
24. And the prince of the tribe of the sons of Ephraim, Kemuel the son of Shiptan.
25. And the prince of the tribe of the sons of Zebulun, Elizaphan the son of Parnach.
26. And the prince of the tribe of the sons of Issachar, Paltiel the son of Azzan.
27. And the prince of the tribe of the sons of Asher, Ahihud the son of Shelomi.
28. And the prince of the tribe of the sons of Naphtali, Pedahel the son of Ammihud.
29. These are they whom the Lord commanded to divide the inheritance to the people of Israel in the land of Canaan.

**Tanach - Numbers Chapter 35**

1. And the Lord spoke to Moses in the plains of Moab by the Jordan at Jericho, saying;
2. Command the people of Israel, that they give to the Levites of the inheritance of their possession cities to live in; and you shall also give to the Levites an open ground around the cities.
3. And they shall have the cities to live in; and their open ground shall be for their cattle, and for their goods, and for all their beasts.
4. And the open ground around the cities, that you shall give to the Levites, shall reach from the wall of the city outward a thousand cubits around.
5. And you shall measure from outside the city on the east side two thousand cubits, and on the south side two thousand cubits, and on the west side two thousand cubits, and on the north side two thousand cubits, and the city shall be in the midst. This shall be to them the open ground of the cities.
6. And the cities which you shall give to the Levites shall be six cities of refuge, which you shall appoint for the man slayer that he may flee there; and to them you shall add forty two cities.
7. So all the cities which you shall give to the Levites shall be forty eight cities; both them and their open grounds.
8. And the cities that you shall give shall be from the possession of the people of Israel; from those who have many you shall give many; and from those who have few you shall give few. Each one shall give of the cities to the Levites according to his inheritance which he inherits.
9. And the Lord spoke to Moses saying;
10. Speak to the people of Israel, and say to them; When you pass over the Jordan into the land of Canaan,
11. Then you shall appoint you cities to be cities of refuge for you; that the man slayer who kills any person unawares may flee there.
12. And they shall be to you cities for refuge from the avenger; that the man slayer should not die, until he stands before the congregation in judgement.
13. And the cities which you shall give shall be six cities for refuge.
14. You shall give three cities in this side of the Jordan, and three cities you shall give in the land of Canaan. They shall be cities of refuge.
15. These six cities shall be a refuge, both for the people of Israel, and for the stranger, and for the sojourner among them, that everyone who kills any person without intent may flee there.
16. But if he hits him with an instrument of iron, so that he dies, he is a murderer; the murderer shall surely be put to death.
17. And if he hits him by hand with a stone, whereby he may die, he is a murderer; the murderer shall surely be put to death.
18. Or if he hits him with a weapon of wood in his hand, whereby he may die, and he dies, he is a murderer; the murderer shall surely be put to death.
19. The avenger of blood shall himself slay the murderer; when he meets him, he shall slay him.
20. And if he stabbed him out of hatred, or hurled something at him while lying in wait, that he died;
21. Or if in enmity he hits him with his hand, so that he dies; he who hit him shall surely be put to death, for he is a murderer. The avenger of blood shall slay the murderer when he meets him.
22. But if he stabbed him suddenly without enmity, or hurled upon him anything without lying in wait;
23. Or with any stone, whereby a man may die, without seeing him, and cast upon him, that he died, and he was not his enemy, nor sought his harm;
24. Then the congregation shall judge between the man slayer and the avenger of blood, according to these judgments.

**Bamidbar 33:1.** These are the *journeys* (מִסְעָיִם) of the people of Israel, which went forth out of the land of Egypt with their armies under the hand of Moses and Aaron.

25. And the congregation shall deliver the slayer from the hand of the avenger of blood, and the congregation shall restore him to his city of refuge, where he had fled; and he shall live there until the death of the high priest, who was anointed with the holy oil.

26. But if the man slayer shall at any time go outside the border of the city of his refuge, where he had fled.

27. And the avenger of blood finds him outside the borders of the city of his refuge, and the avenger of blood kills the slayer, he shall not be guilty of blood.

28. Because he must remain in his city of refuge, until the death of the high priest; but after the death of the high priest the man slayer may return to the land of his possession.

29. And these things shall be for a statute of judgement to you throughout your generations in all your dwellings.

30. Whoever kills any person, the murderer shall be put to death by the evidence of witnesses, but one witness shall not testify against any person to cause him to die.

31. Moreover, you shall take no ransom for the life of a murderer, who is guilty of death, but he shall surely be put to death.

32. And you shall take no ransom for him who has fled to his city of refuge, that he should come back to live in the land, until the death of the priest.

33. So you shall not pollute the land in which you are, for blood pollutes the land; and the land can not be cleansed of the blood that is shed there, but by the blood of him who shed it.

34. And you shall not defile the land which you shall inhabit, in which I dwell; for I the Lord dwell among the people of Israel.

**Tanach - Numbers Chapter 36**

1. And the chief fathers of the families of the sons of Gilead, the son of Machir, the son of Manasseh, of the families of the sons of Joseph, came near, and spoke before Moses, and before the princes, the chief fathers of the people of Israel;

2. And they said, The Lord commanded my lord to give the land for an inheritance by lot to the people of Israel; and my lord was commanded by the Lord to give the inheritance of Zelophehad our brother to his daughters.

3. And if they are married to any of the sons of the other tribes of the people of Israel, then shall their inheritance be taken from the inheritance of our fathers, and shall be given to the inheritance of the tribe where they are received; so shall it be taken from the lot of our inheritance.

4. And when the jubilee of the people of Israel shall be, then shall their inheritance be given to the inheritance of the tribe where they are received; so shall their inheritance be taken away from the inheritance of the tribe of our fathers.

5. And Moses commanded the people of Israel according to the word of the Lord, saying, The tribe of the sons of Joseph has said well.

6. This is the thing which the Lord does command concerning the daughters of Zelophehad, saying, Let them marry whom they think best; only to the family of the tribe of their father shall they marry.

7. So shall not the inheritance of the people of Israel move from tribe to tribe; for every one of the people of Israel shall keep himself to the inheritance of the tribe of his fathers.

8. And every daughter, who possesses an inheritance in any tribe of the people of Israel, shall be the wife to one of the family of the tribe of her father, that the people of Israel may enjoy every man the inheritance of his fathers.

9. Neither shall the inheritance move from one tribe to another tribe; but every one of the tribes of the people of Israel shall keep himself to his own inheritance.

10. As the Lord commanded Moses, so did the daughters of Zelophehad;

11. For Mahlah, Tirzah, and Hoglah, and Milcah, and Noah, the daughters of Zelophehad, were married to their father's brothers' sons;

12. And they were married into the families of the sons of Manasseh the son of Joseph, and their inheritance remained in the tribe of the family of their father.

13. These are the commandments and the judgments, which the Lord commanded by the hand of Moses to the people of Israel in the plains of Moab by the Jordan near Jericho.

**Haftarah JEREMIAH 2:4-28; 3:4; 4:1-2**

**Tanach - Jeremiah Chapter 2**

4. Hear the word of the Lord, O house of Jacob, and all the families of the house of Israel;

**Bamidbar 33:1.** These are the *journeys* (מִסְעָיִם) of the people of Israel, which went forth out of the land of Egypt with their armies under the hand of Moses and Aaron.

5. Thus said the Lord, What iniquity have your fathers found in me, that they have gone far from me, and have walked after vanity, and have become themselves worthless?

9. Therefore I will yet plead with you, says the Lord, and with your children's children will I plead.
10. For cross over to the islands of Kittim, and see; and send to Kedar, and consider diligently, and see if there is such a thing.
11. Has a nation changed their gods, even though they are no gods? but my people have changed their glory for that which does not profit.
12. Be astonished, O you heavens, at this, and be horribly afraid, be greatly appalled, said the Lord.
13. For my people have committed two evils; they have forsaken me, the fountain of living waters, and dug cisterns for themselves, broken cisterns, that can hold no water.
14. Is Israel a servant? Is he a homeborn slave? Why has he become a prey?
15. (K) The young lions roared against him, they roared loudly, and they made his land a waste; his cities are burned, without inhabitant.
16. (K) Also the people of Noph and Tahpanhes have broken the crown of your head.
17. Have you not done this to yourself, in that you have forsaken the Lord your God, when he led you on the way?
18. And now what do you gain by going to Egypt? To drink the waters of Sihor? Or what do you gain by going to Assyria? To drink the waters of the river?
19. Your own wickedness shall correct you, and your backslidings shall reprove you; know therefore and see that it is an evil thing and bitter, that you have forsaken the Lord your God, and that my fear is not in you, says the Lord God of hosts.
20. (K) For long ago I have broken your yoke, and burst your bonds; and you said, I will not transgress; when upon every high hill and under every green tree you bowed down playing the harlot.
21. And I had planted you a noble vine, wholly a right seed; how then have you turned into the degenerate plant of a strange vine to me?
22. For though you wash you with lye, and use much soap, yet the stain of your iniquity is before me, said the Lord God.
23. How can you say, I am not polluted, I have not gone after Baalim? See your way in the valley, know what you have done; you are a restive young camel doubling back on its tracks;
24. (K) A wild ass used to the wilderness, sniffing the wind in its desire; in its lust who can turn it away? All those who seek it need not weary themselves; in its month they shall find it.
25. (K) Withhold your foot from being unshod, and your throat from thirst; but you said, There is no hope; no; for I have loved strangers, and after them will I go.
26. As the thief is ashamed when he is found, so is the house of Israel ashamed; they, their kings, their princes, and their priests, and their prophets,
27. (K) Who say to a piece of wood, You are my father; and to a stone, You have brought me forth; for they have turned their back to me, and not their face; but in the time of their trouble they will say, Arise, and save us.
28. But where are your gods that you have made for yourself? Let them arise, if they can save you in the time of your trouble; for as many as your cities are your gods, O Judah.

and these are their stages according to their starting places. 3 They set out **from Rameses in the first month, on the fifteenth day of the first month**; on the day after the passover the Israelites went out boldly **in the sight of all the Egyptians**. 4 while the Egyptians were burying all their firstborn, whom the LORD had struck down among them. **The LORD executed judgments even against their gods**. 5 So the Israelites set out from Rameses, and camped at Succoth. 6 They set out **from Succoth**, and camped at Etham, which is on the edge of the wilderness. 7 They set out **from Etham**, and turned back to Pi-hahiroth, which faces Baal-zephon; and they camped before Migdol. 8 They set out **from Pi-hahiroth**, passed through the sea into the wilderness, went a three days' journey in the wilderness of Etham, and camped at Marah. 9 They set out **from Marah** and came to Elim; at Elim there were **twelve springs of water and seventy palm trees**, and they camped there. 10 They set out **from Elim** and camped by the Red Sea. 11 They set out **from the Red Sea** and camped in the wilderness of Sin. 12 They set out **from the wilderness of Sin** and camped at Dophkah. 13 They set out **from Dophkah** and camped at Alush. 14 They set out **from Alush** and camped at Rephidim, where there was no water for the people to drink. 15 They set out **from Rephidim** and camped in the wilderness of Sinai. 16 They set out **from the wilderness of Sinai** and camped at Kibroth-hattaavah. 17 They set out **from Kibroth-hattaavah** and camped at Hazereth. 18 They set out **from Hazereth** and camped at Rithmah. 19 They set out **from Rithmah** and camped at Rimmon-perez. 20 They set out **from Rimmon-perez** and camped at Libnah. 21 They set out **from Libnah** and camped at Rissah. 22 They set out **from Rissah** and camped at Kehelathah. 23 They set out **from Kehelathah** and camped at Mount Shepher. 24 They set out **from Mount Shepher** and camped at Haradah. 25 They set out **from Haradah** and camped at Makheloth. 26 They set out **from Makheloth** and camped at Tahath. 27 They set out **from Tahath** and camped at Terah. 28 They set out **from Terah** and camped at Mithkah. 29 They set out **from Mithkah** and camped at Hashmonah. 30 They set out **from Hashmonah** and camped at Moseroth. 31 They set out **from Moseroth** and camped at Bene-jaakan. 32 They set out **from Bene-jaakan** and camped at Hor-haggidgad. 33 They set out **from Hor-haggidgad** and camped at Jotbathah. 34 They set out **from Jotbathah** and camped at Abronah. 35 They set out **from Abronah** and camped at Ezion-geber. 36 They set out **from Ezion-geber** and camped in the wilderness of Zin (that is, Kadesh). 37 They set out **from Kadesh** and camped at Mount Hor, on the edge of the land of Edom. 38 **Aaron the priest went up Mount Hor** at the command of the LORD **and died there in the fortieth year** after the Israelites had come out of the land of Egypt, **on the first day of the fifth month**. 39 Aaron was one hundred twenty-three years old when he died on Mount Hor. 40 **The Canaanite, the king of Arad**, who lived in the Negeb in the land of Canaan, **heard of the coming of the Israelites**. 41 They set out **from Mount Hor** and camped at Zalmonah. 42 They set out **from Zalmonah** and camped at Punon. 43 They set out **from Punon** and camped at Oboth. 44 They set out **from Oboth** and camped at Iye-abarim, in the territory of Moab. 45 They set out **from Iyim** and camped at Dibon-gad. 46 They set out **from Dibon-gad** and camped at Almon-diblathaim. 47 They set out **from Almon-diblathaim** and camped in the mountains of Abarim, before Nebo. 48 They set out **from the mountains of Abarim** and camped in **the plains of Moab by the Jordan at Jericho**; 49 they camped by the Jordan from Beth-jeshimoth as far as Abel-shittim in the plains of Moab. 50 In the plains of Moab by the Jordan at Jericho, the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: 51 **Speak to the Israelites**, and say to them: **When you cross over the Jordan into the land of Canaan**, 52 **you shall drive out all the inhabitants of the land from before you, destroy all their figured stones, destroy all their cast images, and demolish all their high places**. 53 **You shall take possession of the land and settle in it, for I have given you the land to possess**. 54 **You shall apportion the land by lot according to your clans**; to a large one you shall give a large inheritance, and to a small one you shall give a small inheritance; the inheritance shall belong to the person on whom the lot falls; **according to your ancestral tribes you shall inherit**. 55 **But if you do not drive out the inhabitants of the land from before you, then those whom you let remain shall be as barbs in your eyes and thorns in your sides; **NRS Numbers 35:1** In the plains of Moab by the Jordan at Jericho, the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: 2 Command the Israelites to **give**, from the inheritance that they possess, **towns for the Levites** to live in; you shall also give to the Levites **pasture lands surrounding the towns.** 3 The towns shall be theirs to live in, **and their pasture lands shall be for their cattle, for their livestock, and for all their animals.** 4 The pasture lands of the towns, which you shall give to the Levites, shall reach **from the wall of the town outward a thousand cubits all around.** 5 You shall measure, outside the town, **for the east side two thousand cubits,** for **the south side two thousand cubits,** for **the west side two thousand cubits,** and for **the north side two thousand cubits,** with **the town in the middle;** this shall belong to them as pasture land for their towns. 6 **The towns that you give to the Levites shall include the six cities of refuge, where you shall permit a slayer to flee, and in addition to them you shall give forty-two towns.** 7 The towns that you give to the Levites shall total forty-eight, with their pasture lands. 8 And as for the towns that you shall give from the possession of the Israelites, **from the larger tribes you shall take many, and from the smaller tribes you shall take few; each, in proportion to the inheritance that it obtains, shall give of its towns to the Levites.** 9 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying: 10 Speak to the Israelites, and say to them: When you cross the Jordan into the land of Canaan, 11 **then you shall select cities to be cities of refuge for you, so that a slayer who kills a person without intent may flee there.** 12 The cities shall be for you **a refuge from the avenger, so that the slayer may not die until there is a trial before the congregation.** 13 The cities that you designate shall be six cities of refuge for you: 14 **you shall designate three cities beyond the Jordan, and three cities in the land of Canaan,** to be cities of refuge. 15 These six cities shall serve as **refuge** for the Israelites, for the resident or transient alien among them, so that **anyone who kills a person without intent may flee there.** 16 **But anyone who strikes another with an iron object, and death ensues, is a murderer;** the murderer shall be put to death. 17 Or **anyone who strikes another with a stone in hand**

that could cause death, and death ensues, is a murderer; the murderer shall be put to death. 18 Or anyone who strikes another with a weapon of wood in hand that could cause death, and death ensues, is a murderer; the murderer shall be put to death. 19 The avenger of blood is the one who shall put the murderer to death; when they meet, the avenger of blood shall execute the sentence. 20 Likewise, if someone pushes another from hatred, or hurls something at another, lying in wait, and death ensues, 21 or in enmity strikes another with the hand, and death ensues, then the one who struck the blow shall be put to death; that person is a murderer; the avenger of blood shall put the murderer to death, when they meet. 22 But if someone pushes another suddenly without enmity, or hurls any object without lying in wait, 23 or, while handling any stone that could cause death, unintentionally drops it on another and death ensues, though they were not enemies, and no harm was intended, 24 then the congregation shall judge between the slayer and the avenger of blood, in accordance with these ordinances; 25 and the congregation shall rescue the slayer from the avenger of blood. Then the congregation shall send the slayer back to the original city of refuge. The slayer shall live in it until the death of the high priest who was anointed with the holy oil. 26 But if the slayer shall at any time go outside the bounds of the original city of refuge, 27 and is found by the avenger of blood outside the bounds of the city of refuge, and is killed by the avenger, no bloodguilt shall be incurred. 28 For the slayer must remain in the city of refuge until the death of the high priest; but after the death of the high priest the slayer may return home. 29 These things shall be a statute and ordinance for you throughout your generations wherever you live. 30 If anyone kills another, the murderer shall be put to death on the evidence of witnesses; but no one shall be put to death on the testimony of a single witness. 31 Moreover you shall accept no ransom for the life of a murderer who is subject to the death penalty; a murderer must be put to death. 32 Nor shall you accept ransom for one who has fled to a city of refuge, enabling the fugitive to return to live in the land before the death of the high priest. 33 You shall not pollute the land in which you live; for blood

pollutes the land, and no expiation can be made for the land, for the blood that is shed in it, except by the blood of the one who shed it. 34 You shall not defile the land in which you live, in which I also dwell; for I the LORD dwell among the Israelites.

NRS Numbers 36:1 The heads of the ancestral houses of the clans of the descendants of Gilead son of Machir son of Manasseh, of the Josephite clans, came forward and spoke in the presence of Moses and the leaders, the heads of the ancestral houses of the Israelites; 2 they said, "The LORD commanded my lord to give the land for inheritance by lot to the Israelites; and my lord was commanded by the LORD to give the inheritance of our brother Zelophehad to his daughters. 3 But if they are married into another Israelite tribe, then their inheritance will be taken from the inheritance of our ancestors and added to the inheritance of the tribe into which they marry; so it will be taken away from the allotted portion of our inheritance. 4 And when the jubilee of the Israelites comes, then their inheritance will be added to the inheritance of the tribe into which they have married; and their inheritance will be taken from the inheritance of our ancestral tribe." 5 Then Moses commanded the Israelites according to the word of the LORD, saying, "The descendants of the tribe of Joseph are right in what they are saying. 6 This is what the LORD commands concerning the daughters of Zelophehad, 'Let them marry whom they think best; only it must be into a clan of their father's tribe that they are married, 7 so that no inheritance of the Israelites shall be transferred from one tribe to another: for all Israelites shall retain the inheritance of their ancestral tribes. 8 Every daughter who possesses an inheritance in any tribe of the Israelites shall marry one from the clan of her father's tribe, so that all Israelites may continue to possess their ancestral inheritance. 9 No inheritance shall be transferred from one tribe to another; for each of the tribes of the Israelites shall retain its own inheritance." 10 The daughters of Zelophehad did as the LORD had commanded Moses. 11 Mahlah, Tirzah, Hoglah, Milcah, and Noah, the daughters of Zelophehad, married sons of their father's brothers. 12 They were married into the clans of the descendants of Manasseh son of Joseph, and their inheritance remained in the tribe of their father's clan. 13 These are the commandments and the ordinances that the LORD commanded through Moses to the Israelites in the plains of Moab by the Jordan at Jericho.

on the morrow after the passover the children of Israel went out with an high hand in the sight of all the Egyptians. 4 For the Egyptians buried all *their* firstborn, which the LORD had smitten among them: upon **their gods** [וּבְאֱלֹהֵיהֶם] also the LORD executed **judgments** [שְׁפָטִים]. 5 And the children of Israel removed from Rameses, and pitched in Succoth. 6 And they departed from Succoth, and pitched in Etham, which *is* in the edge of **the wilderness** [הַמִּדְבָּר]. 7 And they removed from Etham, and turned again unto Pihahiroth, which *is* before Baalzephon: and they pitched before Migdol. 8 And they departed from before Pihahiroth, and passed through the midst of the sea into the wilderness, and went three days' journey in the wilderness of Etham, and pitched in Marah. 9 And they removed from Marah, and came unto Elim: and in Elim *were* twelve fountains of water, and threescore and ten palm trees; and they pitched there. 10 And they removed from Elim, and encamped by the Red sea. 11 And they removed from the Red sea, and encamped **in the wilderness of Sin** [בְּמִדְבַר־סִינַי]. 12 And they took their journey out of the wilderness of Sin, and encamped in Dophkah. 13 And they departed from Dophkah, and encamped in Alush. 14 And they removed from Alush, and encamped at Rephidim, where was **no water for the people to drink.** 15 And they departed from Rephidim, and pitched **in the wilderness of Sinai** [בְּמִדְבַר־סִינַי]. 16 And they removed from the desert of Sinai, and pitched at Kibrothhattaavah. 17 And they departed from Kibrothhattaavah, and encamped at Hazeroth. 18 And they departed from Hazeroth, and pitched in Rithmah. 19 And they departed from Rithmah, and pitched at Rimmonparez. 20 And they departed from Rimmonparez, and pitched in Libnah. 21 And they removed from Libnah, and pitched at Rissah. 22 And they journeyed from Rissah, and pitched in Kehelathah. 23 And they went from Kehelathah, and pitched in mount Shapher. 24 And they removed from mount Shapher, and encamped in Haradah. 25 And they removed from Haradah, and pitched in Makheloth. 26 And they removed from Makheloth, and encamped at Tahath. 27 And they departed from Tahath, and pitched at Tarah. 28 And they removed from Tarah, and pitched in Mithcah. 29 And they went from Mithcah, and pitched in Hashmonah. 30 And they departed from Hashmonah, and encamped at Moseroth. 31 And they departed from Moseroth, and pitched in Benejaakan. 32 And they removed from Benejaakan, and encamped at Horhagidgad. 33 And they went from Horhagidgad, and pitched in Jotbathah. 34 And they removed from Jotbathah, and encamped at Ebronah. 35 And they departed from Ebronah, and encamped at Eziongaber. 36 And they removed from Eziongaber, and pitched **in the wilderness of Zin** [בְּמִדְבַר־צִין], which *is* Kadesh. 37 And they removed from Kadesh, and pitched in mount Hor, in the edge of **the land of Edom** [אֶרֶץ־עֲדוֹם]. 38 And Aaron the priest went up into mount Hor at **the commandment of the LORD** [עַל־פִּי־יְהוָה], and died there, in the fortieth year after the children of Israel were come out of the land of Egypt, in the first *day* of the fifth month. 39 And Aaron *was* an hundred and twenty and three years old when he died in mount Hor. 40 And king Arad the Canaanite, which dwelt in the south in the land of Canaan, heard of the coming of the children of Israel. 41 And they departed from mount Hor, and pitched in Zalmonah. 42 And they departed from Zalmonah, and pitched in Punon. 43 And they departed from Punon, and pitched in Oboth. 44 And they departed from Oboth, and pitched in Ijeabarim, in the border of Moab. 45 And they departed from Iim, and pitched in Dibongad. 46 And they removed from Dibongad, and encamped in Almondiblathaim. 47 And they removed from Almondiblathaim, and pitched in the mountains of Abarim, before Nebo. 48 And they departed from the mountains of Abarim, and pitched in the plains of Moab by Jordan *near* Jericho. 49 And they pitched by Jordan, from Bethjesimoth *even* unto Abelshittim in the plains of Moab. 50 And the LORD spake unto Moses in the plains of Moab by Jordan *near* Jericho, saying, 51 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye are passed over Jordan into the land of Canaan; 52 Then ye shall drive out all the inhabitants of the land from before you, and destroy **all their pictures** [כָּל־מִשְׁכֵּבֵיהֶם], and destroy **all their molten images** [כָּל־צַלְמֵי־מַסַּכְתָּם], and quite pluck down **all their high places**

[כָּל-בְּמֹתָם]: 53 And ye shall dispossess *the inhabitants* of the land, and dwell therein: for I have given you the land to possess it. 54 And ye shall divide the land by lot for an inheritance among your families: *and* to the more ye shall give the more inheritance, and to the fewer ye shall give the less inheritance: every man's *inheritance* shall be in the place where his lot falleth; according to the tribes of your fathers ye shall inherit. 55 But if ye will not drive out the inhabitants of the land from before you; then it shall come to pass, that those which ye let remain of them *shall be* pricks in your eyes, and thorns in your sides, and shall vex you in the land wherein ye dwell. 56 Moreover it shall come to pass, *that* I shall do unto you, as I thought to do unto them.

**KJV Numbers 34:1** And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 2 Command the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye come into the land of Canaan; (this *is* the land that shall fall unto you for an inheritance, *even* the land of Canaan with the coasts thereof:) 3 Then your **south** [נֶגֶב] quarter shall be from the wilderness of Zin along by the coast of Edom, and your south border shall be the outmost coast of the salt sea **eastward** [קִדְמוֹהַי]: 4 And your border shall turn from the south to the ascent of Akkrabbim, and pass on to Zin: and the going forth thereof shall be from the south to Kadeshbarnea, and shall go on to Hazaraddar, and pass on to Azmon: 5 And the border shall fetch a compass from Azmon unto **the river of Egypt** [נַחֲלֵהּ מִצְרַיִם], and the goings out of it shall be at the sea. 6 And *as for* the **western** [יָם] border, ye shall even have the great sea for a border: this shall be your west border. 7 And this shall be your **north** [צָפוֹן] border: from the great sea ye shall point out for you mount Hor: 8 From mount Hor ye shall point out *your border* unto the entrance of Hamath; and the goings forth of the border shall be to Zedad: 9 And the border shall go on to Ziphron, and the goings out of it shall be at Hazarenan: this shall be your north border. 10 And ye shall point out your **east** [קִדְמוֹהַי] border from Hazarenan to Shepham: 11 And the coast shall go down from Shepham to Riblah, on the east side of Ain; and the border shall descend, and shall reach unto the side of **the sea of Chinnereth** [יָם-כִּנְרֵת] eastward: 12 And the border shall go down to Jordan, and the goings out of it shall be at **the salt sea** [יָם הַמֶּלַח]: this shall be your land with the coasts thereof round about. 13 And Moses commanded the children of Israel, saying, This *is* the land which ye shall inherit by lot, which the LORD commanded to give unto the nine tribes, and to the half tribe: 14 For the tribe of the children of Reuben according to **the house of their fathers** [לְבֵית אֲבֹתָם], and the tribe of the children of Gad according to **the house of their fathers** [לְבֵית אֲבֹתָם], have received *their inheritance*; and half the tribe of Manasseh have received their inheritance: 15 The two tribes and the half tribe have received their inheritance on this side Jordan *near* Jericho eastward, **toward the sunrising** [מִזְרְחָהּ]. 16 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 17 These *are* the names of the men which shall divide the land unto you: Eleazar the priest, and Joshua the son of Nun. 18 And ye shall take **one prince of every tribe** [אֶחָד נָשִׂיא אֶחָד מִמִּטֵּה], to divide the land by inheritance. 19 And the names of the men *are* these: Of the tribe of Judah, Caleb the son of Jephunneh. 20 And of the tribe of the children of Simeon, Shemuel the son of Ammihud. 21 Of the tribe of Benjamin, Elidad the son of Chislon. 22 And the prince of the tribe of the children of Dan, Bukki the son of Jogli. 23 The prince of the children of Joseph, for the tribe of the children of Manasseh, Hanniel the son of Ephod. 24 And the prince of the tribe of the children of Ephraim, **Kemuel** [קִמּוֹאֵל] the son of Shiphtan. 25 And the prince of the tribe of the children of Zebulun, Elizaphan the son of Parnach. 26 And the prince of the tribe of the children of Issachar, Paltiel the son of Azzan. 27 And the prince of the tribe of the children of Asher, Ahihud the son of Shelomi. 28 And the prince of the tribe of the children of Naphtali, Pedahel the son of Ammihud. 29 These *are they* whom the LORD commanded to divide the inheritance unto the children of Israel in the land of Canaan.

**KJV Numbers 35:1** And the LORD spake unto Moses in the plains of Moab by Jordan *near* Jericho, saying, 2 Command the children of Israel, that they give unto the Levites of the inheritance of their possession **cities** [עָרִים] to dwell in; and ye shall give *also* unto the Levites **suburbs** [וּמִגְרָשׁ] for the cities round about them. 3 And the cities shall they have to dwell in; and the suburbs of them shall be for **their cattle** [לְבֵהֵמֹתָם], and for **their goods** [וְלִדְרֹכָשָׁם], and for **all their beasts** [וְלִכְלֵל חַיֹּתָם]. 4 And

the suburbs of the cities, which ye shall give unto the Levites, *shall reach* from the wall of the city and outward a thousand cubits round about. 5 And ye shall measure from without the city on the east side two thousand cubits, and on the south side two thousand cubits, and on the west side two thousand cubits, and on the north side two thousand cubits; and the city *shall be* in the midst: this shall be to them the suburbs of the cities. 6 And among the cities which ye shall give unto the Levites *there shall be six cities for refuge* [אֵת שְׁשֵׁעָרֵי הַמְּקֻלָּטִים], which ye shall appoint for the manslayer, that he may flee thither: and to them ye shall add forty and two cities. 7 So all the cities which ye shall give to the Levites *shall be* forty and eight cities: them *shall ye give* with their suburbs. 8 And the cities which ye shall give *shall be* of the possession of the children of Israel: from *them that have* many ye shall give many; but from *them that have* few ye shall give few: every one shall give of his cities unto the Levites according to his inheritance which he inheriteth. 9 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 10 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come over Jordan into the land of Canaan; 11 Then ye shall appoint you cities to be cities of refuge for you; that the slayer may flee thither, which killeth any person at *unawares* [בְּשִׁנְנָה]. 12 And they shall be unto you cities for refuge from the avenger; that the manslayer die not, until he stand **before the congregation in judgment** [לְפָנֵי הָעֵדָה לְמִשְׁפָּט]. 13 And of these cities which ye shall give six cities shall ye have for refuge. 14 Ye shall give three cities on this side Jordan, and three cities shall ye give **in the land of Canaan** [בְּאֶרֶץ כְּנָעַן], which shall be cities of refuge. 15 These six cities shall be a refuge, *both* for **the children of Israel** [בְּנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל], and for **the stranger** [גֵּר], and for **the sojourner** [תּוֹשָׁב] among them: that every one that killeth any person unawares may flee thither. 16 And if he smite him with an instrument of iron, so that he die, he *is* a murderer: the murderer shall surely be put to death. 17 And if he smite him with throwing a stone, wherewith he may die, and he die, he *is* a murderer: the murderer shall surely be put to death. 18 Or *if* he smite him with an hand weapon of wood, wherewith he may die, and he die, he *is* a murderer: the murderer **shall surely be put to death** [מִוֹת יוֹמָת]. 19 The revenger of blood himself shall slay the murderer: when he meeteth him, he shall slay him. 20 But if he thrust him of **hatred** [וְאִם-בְּשִׂנְאָה], or hurl at him by laying of wait, that he die; 21 Or in enmity smite him with his hand, that he die: he that smote *him* shall surely be put to death; *for* he *is* a murderer: the revenger of blood shall slay the murderer, when he meeteth him. 22 But if he thrust him suddenly without enmity, or have cast upon him any thing without laying of wait, 23 Or with any stone, wherewith a man may die, seeing *him* not, and cast *it* upon him, that he die, and *was* not his enemy, neither sought his harm: 24 Then the congregation shall **judge** [וְשָׁפֵטוּ] between the slayer and the revenger of blood according to **these judgments** [הַמִּשְׁפָּטִים]: 25 And the congregation shall deliver the slayer out of the hand of the revenger of blood, and the congregation shall restore him to the city of his refuge, whither he was fled: and he shall abide in it unto the death of **the high priest, which was anointed with the holy oil** [הַקֹּדֵשׁ]. 26 But if the slayer shall at any time come without the border of the city of his refuge, whither he was fled; 27 And the revenger of blood find him without the borders of the city of his refuge, and the revenger of blood kill the slayer; he shall not be guilty of blood: 28 Because he should have remained in the city of his refuge until the death of the high priest: but after the death of the high priest the slayer shall return into the land of his possession. 29 So these *things* shall be for **a statute of judgment** [לְחֻקַּת מִשְׁפָּט] unto you throughout your generations in all your dwellings. 30 **Whoso killeth any person, the murderer shall be put to death by the mouth of witnesses** [לְפִי עֵדִים]: **but one witness** [עֵד אֶחָד] shall not testify against any person *to cause him* to die. 31 Moreover ye shall take no satisfaction for the life of a murderer, which *is* guilty of death: **but he shall be surely put to death** [יוֹמָת כִּי-מוֹת]. 32 And ye shall take no satisfaction for him that is fled to the city of his refuge, that he should come again to dwell in the land, until the death of the priest. 33 So ye shall not pollute the land wherein ye *are*: for **blood it defileth the land** [וְהַדָּם הוּא יִתְנִיף אֶת-הָאָרֶץ]: and **the land cannot be cleansed of the blood that is shed therein, but by the blood of him**

**KJV Numbers 36:1** And the chief fathers of the families of the children of Gilead, the son of Machir, the son of Manasseh, of the families of the sons of Joseph, came near, and spake before Moses, and before the princes, the chief fathers of the children of Israel: 2 And they said, The LORD commanded my lord to give the land for an inheritance by lot to the children of Israel: and my lord was commanded by the LORD to give the inheritance of **Zelophehad** [זֶלְפַּחָד] our brother unto his daughters. 3 And if they be married to any of the sons of the *other tribes of the children of Israel* [שְׁבֵטֵי בְנֵי־יִשְׂרָאֵל], then shall their inheritance be taken from the inheritance of our fathers, and shall be put to the inheritance of the tribe whereunto they are received: so shall it be taken from the lot of our inheritance. 4 And when **the jubile of the children of Israel** [הַיְבֻל לְבְנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל] shall be, then shall their inheritance be put unto the inheritance of the tribe whereunto they are received: so shall their inheritance be taken away from the inheritance of the tribe of our fathers. 5 And Moses commanded the children of Israel according to **the word of the LORD** [עַל־פִּי יְהוָה], saying, The tribe of the sons of Joseph hath said well. 6 This *is* the thing which the LORD doth command concerning the daughters of Zelophehad, saying, Let them marry to whom they think best; only to the family of the tribe of their father shall they marry. 7 So shall not the inheritance of the children of Israel remove from tribe to tribe: for every one of the children of Israel shall keep himself to the inheritance of the tribe of his fathers. 8 And every daughter, that possesseth an inheritance in any tribe of the children of Israel, shall be wife unto one of the family of the tribe of her father, that the children of Israel may enjoy every man the inheritance of his fathers. 9 Neither shall the inheritance remove from *one* tribe to another tribe; but every one of the tribes of the children of Israel shall keep himself to his own inheritance. 10 Even as the LORD commanded Moses, so did the daughters of Zelophehad: 11 For Mahlah, Tirzah, and Hoglah, and Milcah, and Noah, the daughters of Zelophehad, were married unto their father's brothers' sons: 12 *And* they were married into the families of the sons of Manasseh the son of Joseph, and their inheritance remained in the tribe of the family of their father. 13 These *are* **the commandments and the judgments** [הַמִּצְוֹת וְהַמִּשְׁפָּטִים] which **the LORD commanded by the hand of Moses** [צִוָּה יְהוָה בְּיַד־מֹשֶׁה] **unto the children of Israel** [לְבְנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל] in the plains of Moab by Jordan *near* Jericho.

**KJV Numbers 33:1** These *are* the journeys of the children of Israel, which went forth out of the land of Egypt with their armies under the hand of Moses and Aaron. 2 And Moses wrote their goings out according to their journeys by the commandment of the LORD: and these *are* their journeys according to their goings out. 3 And they departed from Rameses in the first month, on the fifteenth day of the first month; on the morrow after the passover the children of Israel went out with an high hand in the sight of all the Egyptians. 4 For the Egyptians buried all *their* firstborn, which the LORD had smitten among them: upon *their* gods also the LORD executed judgments. 5 And the children of Israel removed from Rameses, and pitched in Succoth. 6 And they departed from Succoth, and pitched in Etham, which *is* in the edge of the wilderness. 7 And they removed from Etham, and turned again unto Pihahiroth, which *is* before Baalzephon: and they pitched before Migdol. 8 And they departed from before Pihahiroth, and passed through the midst of the sea into the wilderness, and went three days' journey in the wilderness of Etham, and pitched in Marah. 9 And they removed from Marah, and came unto Elim: and in Elim *were* twelve fountains of water, and threescore and ten palm trees; and they pitched there. 10 And they removed from Elim, and encamped by the Red sea. 11 And they removed from the Red sea, and encamped in the wilderness of Sin. 12 And they took their journey out of the wilderness of Sin, and encamped in Dophkah. 13 And they departed from Dophkah, and encamped in Alush. 14 And they removed from Alush, and encamped at Rephidim, where was no water for the people to drink. 15 And they departed from Rephidim, and pitched in the wilderness of Sinai. 16 And they removed from the desert of Sinai, and pitched at Kibrothhattaavah. 17 And they departed from Kibrothhattaavah, and encamped at Hazeroth. 18 And they departed from Hazeroth, and pitched in Rithmah. 19 And they departed from Rithmah, and pitched at Rimmonparez. 20 And they departed from Rimmonparez, and pitched in Libnah. 21 And they removed from Libnah, and pitched at Rissah. 22 And they journeyed from Rissah, and pitched in Kehelathah. 23 And they went from Kehelathah, and pitched in mount Shapher. 24 And they removed from mount Shapher, and encamped in Haradah. 25 And they removed from Haradah, and pitched in Makheloth. 26 And they removed from Makheloth, and encamped at Tahath. 27 And they departed from Tahath, and pitched at Tarah. 28 And they removed from Tarah, and pitched in Mithcah. 29 And they went from Mithcah, and pitched in Hashmonah. 30 And they departed from Hashmonah, and encamped at Moseroth. 31 And they departed from Moseroth, and pitched in Benejaakan. 32 And they removed from Benejaakan, and encamped at Horhagidgad. 33 And they went from Horhagidgad, and pitched in Jotbathah. 34 And they removed from Jotbathah, and encamped at Ebronah. 35 And they departed from Ebronah, and encamped at Eziongaber. 36 And they removed from Eziongaber, and pitched in the wilderness of Zin, which *is* Kadesh. 37 And they removed from Kadesh, and pitched in mount Hor, in the edge of the land of Edom. 38 And Aaron the priest went up into mount Hor at the commandment of the LORD, and died there, in the fortieth year after the children of Israel were come out of the land of Egypt, in the first *day* of the fifth month. 39 And Aaron *was* an hundred and twenty and three years old when he died in mount Hor.

--**KJV Exodus 15:22** So Moses brought Israel from the Red sea, and they went out into the wilderness of Shur; and they went three days in the wilderness, and found no water.

--**KJV Exodus 15:27** And they came to Elim, where *were* twelve wells of water, and threescore and ten palm trees: and they encamped there by the waters.

--**KJV Exodus 16:1** And they took their journey from Elim, and all the congregation of the children of Israel came unto the wilderness of Sin, which *is* between Elim and Sinai, on the fifteenth day of the second month after their departing out of the land of Egypt.

--**KJV Exodus 15:23** And when they came to Marah, they could not drink of the waters of Marah, for they *were* bitter: therefore the name of it was called Marah. 24 And the people murmured against Moses, saying, What shall we drink? 25 And he cried unto the LORD; and the LORD shewed him a tree, *which* when he had cast into the waters, the waters were made sweet: there he made for them a statute and an ordinance, and there he proved them,

--**KJV Exodus 18:6** And he said unto Moses, I thy father in law Jethro am come unto thee, and thy wife, and her two sons with her. 7 And Moses went out to meet his father in law, and did obeisance, and kissed him; and they asked each other of *their* welfare; and they came into the tent. 8 And Moses told his father in law all that the LORD had done unto Pharaoh and to the Egyptians for Israel's sake, *and* all the travail that

had come upon them by the way, and *how* the LORD delivered them. 9 And Jethro rejoiced for all the goodness which the LORD had done to Israel, whom he had delivered out of the hand of the Egyptians. 10 And Jethro said, Blessed *be* the LORD, who hath delivered you out of the hand of the Egyptians, and out of the hand of Pharaoh, who hath delivered the people from under the hand of the Egyptians. 11 Now I know that the LORD *is* greater than all gods: for in the thing wherein they dealt proudly *he was* above them. 12 And Jethro, Moses' father in law, took a burnt offering and sacrifices for God: and Aaron came, and all the elders of Israel, to eat bread with Moses' father in law before God. 13 And it came to pass on the morrow, that Moses sat to judge the people: and the people stood by Moses from the morning unto the evening.

--KJV Numbers 10:11 And it came to pass on the twentieth *day* of the second month, in the second year, that the cloud was taken up from off the tabernacle of the testimony.

--KJV Numbers 11:4 And the mixt multitude that *was* among them fell a lusting: and the children of Israel also wept again, and said, Who shall give us flesh to eat? 5 We remember the fish, which we did eat in Egypt freely; the cucumbers, and the melons, and the leeks, and the onions, and the garlick: 6 But now our soul *is* dried away: *there is* nothing at all, beside this manna, *before* our eyes. 7 And the manna *was* as coriander seed, and the colour thereof as the colour of bdellium. 8 *And* the people went about, and gathered *it*, and ground *it* in mills, or beat *it* in a mortar, and baked *it* in pans, and made cakes of it: and the taste of it was as the taste of fresh oil. 9 And when the dew fell upon the camp in the night, the manna fell upon it. 10 Then Moses heard the people weep throughout their families, every man in the door of his tent: and the anger of the LORD was kindled greatly; Moses also was displeased. 11 And Moses said unto the LORD, Wherefore hast thou afflicted thy servant? and wherefore have I not found favour in thy sight, that thou layest the burden of all this people upon me? 12 Have I conceived all this people? have I begotten them, that thou shouldest say unto me, Carry them in thy bosom, as a nursing father beareth the sucking child, unto the land which thou swarest unto their fathers? 13 Whence should I have flesh to give unto all this people? for they weep unto me, saying, Give us flesh, that we may eat. 14 I am not able to bear all this people alone, because *it is* too heavy for me. 15 And if thou deal thus with me, kill me, I pray thee, out of hand, if I have found favour in thy sight; and let me not see my wretchedness. 16 And the LORD said unto Moses, Gather unto me seventy men of the elders of Israel, whom thou knowest to be the elders of the people, and officers over them; and bring them unto the tabernacle of the congregation, that they may stand there with thee. 17 And I will come down and talk with thee there: and I will take of the spirit which *is* upon thee, and will put *it* upon them; and they shall bear the burden of the people with thee, that thou bear *it* not thyself alone. 18 And say thou unto the people, Sanctify yourselves against to morrow, and ye shall eat flesh: for ye have wept in the ears of the LORD, saying, Who shall give us flesh to eat? for *it was* well with us in Egypt: therefore the LORD will give you flesh, and ye shall eat. 19 Ye shall not eat one day, nor two days, nor five days, neither ten days, nor twenty days; 20 *But* even a whole month, until it come out at your nostrils, and it be loathsome unto you: because that ye have despised the LORD which *is* among you, and have wept before him, saying, Why came we forth out of Egypt? 21 And Moses said, The people, among whom I *am*, *are* six hundred thousand footmen; and thou hast said, I will give them flesh, that they may eat a whole month. 22 Shall the flocks and the herds be slain for them, to suffice them? or shall all the fish of the sea be gathered together for them, to suffice them? 23 And the LORD said unto Moses, Is the LORD'S hand waxed short? thou shalt see now whether my word shall come to pass unto thee or not. 24 And Moses went out, and told the people the words of the LORD, and gathered the seventy men of the elders of the people, and set them round about the tabernacle. 25 And the LORD came down in a cloud, and spake unto him, and took of the spirit that *was* upon him, and gave *it* unto the seventy elders: and it came to pass, *that*, when the spirit rested upon them, they prophesied, and did not cease. 26 But there remained two *of* the men in the camp, the name of the one *was* Eldad, and the name of the other Medad: and the spirit rested upon them; and they *were* of them that were written, but went not out unto the tabernacle: and they prophesied in the camp. 27 And there ran a young man, and told Moses, and said, Eldad and Medad do prophesy in the camp. 28 And Joshua the son of Nun, the servant of Moses, *one* of his young men, answered and said, My lord Moses, forbid them. 29 And Moses said unto him, Enviest thou for my sake? would God that all the LORD'S people were prophets, *and* that the LORD would put his spirit upon them! 30 And Moses gat him into the camp, he and the elders of Israel. 31 And there went forth a wind from the LORD, and brought quails from the sea, and let *them* fall by the camp, as it were a day's journey on this side, and as it were a day's journey on the other side, round about the camp, and as it were two cubits *high* upon the face of the earth. 32 And the people stood up all that day, and all *that* night, and all the next day, and they gathered the quails: he that gathered least gathered ten homers: and they spread *them* all abroad

for themselves round about the camp. 33 And while the flesh *was* yet between their teeth, ere it was chewed, the wrath of the LORD was kindled against the people, and the LORD smote the people with a very great plague. 34 And he called the name of that place Kibrothhattaavah: because there they buried the people that lusted.

--**KJV Numbers 13:26** And they went and came to Moses, and to Aaron, and to all the congregation of the children of Israel, unto the wilderness of Paran, to Kadesh; and brought back word unto them, and unto all the congregation, and shewed them the fruit of the land.

--**KJV Psalm 120:3** What shall be given unto thee? or what shall be done unto thee, thou false tongue?

--**KJV Deuteronomy 1:46** So ye abode in Kadesh many days, according unto the days that ye abode *there*.

--**KJV Numbers 20:13** This *is* the water of Meribah; because the children of Israel strove with the LORD, and he was sanctified in them.

**KJV Numbers 33:40** And king Arad the Canaanite, which dwelt in the south in the land of Canaan, heard of the coming of the children of Israel. 41 And they departed from mount Hor, and pitched in Zalmonah. 42 And they departed from Zalmonah, and pitched in Punon. 43 And they departed from Punon, and pitched in Oboth. 44 And they departed from Oboth, and pitched in Ijeabarim, in the border of Moab. 45 And they departed from Iim, and pitched in Dibongad. 46 And they removed from Dibongad, and encamped in Almondiblathaim. 47 And they removed from Almondiblathaim, and pitched in the mountains of Abarim, before Nebo. 48 And they departed from the mountains of Abarim, and pitched in the plains of Moab by Jordan *near* Jericho. 49 And they pitched by Jordan, from Bethjesimoth *even* unto Abelshittim in the plains of Moab.

--**KJV Numbers 21:1** And *when* king Arad the Canaanite, which dwelt in the south, heard tell that Israel came by the way of the spies; then he fought against Israel, and took *some* of them prisoners. 2 And Israel vowed a vow unto the LORD, and said, If thou wilt indeed deliver this people into my hand, then I will utterly destroy their cities. 3 And the LORD hearkened to the voice of Israel, and delivered up the Canaanites; and they utterly destroyed them and their cities: and he called the name of the place Hormah.

--**KJV Numbers 21:4** And they journeyed from mount Hor by the way of the Red sea, to compass the land of Edom: and the soul of the people was much discouraged because of the way. 5 And the people spake against God, and against Moses, Wherefore have ye brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? for *there is* no bread, neither *is there any* water; and our soul loatheth this light bread. 6 And the LORD sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people; and much people of Israel died. 7 Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, We have sinned, for we have spoken against the LORD, and against thee; pray unto the LORD, that he take away the serpents from us. And Moses prayed for the people. 8 And the LORD said unto Moses, Make thee a fiery serpent, and set it upon a pole: and it shall come to pass, that every one that is bitten, when he looketh upon it, shall live. 9 And Moses made a serpent of brass, and put it upon a pole, and it came to pass, that if a serpent had bitten any man, when he beheld the serpent of brass, he lived. 10 And the children of Israel set forward, and pitched in Oboth.

--**KJV Exodus 23:33** They shall not dwell in thy land, lest they make thee sin against me: for if thou serve their gods, it will surely be a snare unto thee.

--**KJV Exodus 34:11** Observe thou that which I command thee this day: behold, I drive out before thee the Amorite, and the Canaanite, and the Hittite, and the Perizzite, and the Hivite, and the Jebusite. 12 Take heed to thyself, lest thou make a covenant with the inhabitants of the land whither thou goest, lest it be for a snare in the midst of thee:

**KJV Numbers 33:50** And the LORD spake unto Moses in the plains of Moab by Jordan *near* Jericho, saying, 51 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye are passed over Jordan into the land of Canaan; 52 Then ye shall drive out all the inhabitants of the land from before you, and destroy all their pictures, and destroy all their molten images, and quite pluck down all their high places: 53 And ye shall dispossess *the inhabitants* of the land, and dwell therein: for I have given you the land to possess it. 54 And ye shall divide the land by lot for an inheritance among your families: *and to the more ye shall give the more inheritance, and to the fewer ye shall give the less inheritance: every man's inheritance shall be in the place where his lot falleth; according to the tribes of your fathers ye shall inherit.* 55 But if ye will not drive out the inhabitants of the land from before you; then it shall come to pass, that those which ye let remain of them *shall be* pricks in your eyes, and thorns in your sides, and shall vex you in the land wherein ye dwell. 56 Moreover it shall come to pass, *that I shall do unto you, as I thought to do unto them.*

**Bamidbar 33:1.** These are the *journeys* (יְסוּדֹתַי) of the people of Israel, which went forth out of the land of Egypt with their armies under the hand of Moses and Aaron.

--**KJV Numbers 26:56** According to the lot shall the possession thereof be divided between many and few.

**KJV Numbers 34:1** And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 2 Command the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye come into the land of Canaan; (this *is* the land that shall fall unto you for an inheritance, *even* the land of Canaan with the coasts thereof:) 3 Then your south quarter shall be from the wilderness of Zin along by the coast of Edom, and your south border shall be the outmost coast of the salt sea eastward: 4 And your border shall turn from the south to the ascent of Akrabbim, and pass on to Zin: and the going forth thereof shall be from the south to Kadeshbarnea, and shall go on to Hazaraddar, and pass on to Azmon: 5 And the border shall fetch a compass from Azmon unto the river of Egypt, and the goings out of it shall be at the sea. 6 And *as for* the western border, ye shall even have the great sea for a border: this shall be your west border.

--**KJV Joshua 15:3** And it went out to the south side to Maalehacrabim, and passed along to Zin, and ascended up on the south side unto Kadeshbarnea, and passed along to Hezron, and went up to Adar, and fetched a compass to Karkaa:

--**KJV Numbers 12:16** And afterward the people removed from Hazeroth, and pitched in the wilderness of Paran.

--**KJV Numbers 32:8** Thus did your fathers, when I sent them from Kadeshbarnea to see the land.

--**KJV Deuteronomy 1:2** (*There are eleven days' journey* from Horeb by the way of mount Seir unto Kadeshbarnea.)

--**KJV Deuteronomy 1:19** And when we departed from Horeb, we went through all that great and terrible wilderness, which ye saw by the way of the mountain of the Amorites, as the LORD our God commanded us; and we came to Kadeshbarnea.

**KJV Numbers 34:7** And this shall be your north border: from the great sea ye shall point out for you mount Hor: 8 From mount Hor ye shall point out *your border* unto the entrance of Hamath; and the goings forth of the border shall be to Zedad: 9 And the border shall go on to Ziphron, and the goings out of it shall be at Hazarenan: this shall be your north border. 10 And ye shall point out your east border from Hazarenan to Shepham: 11 And the coast shall go down from Shepham to Riblah, on the east side of Ain; and the border shall descend, and shall reach unto the side of the sea of Chinnereth eastward: 12 And the border shall go down to Jordan, and the goings out of it shall be at the salt sea: this shall be your land with the coasts thereof round about.

--**KJV Numbers 20:22** And the children of Israel, *even* the whole congregation, journeyed from Kadesh, and came unto mount Hor. 23 And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron in mount Hor, by the coast of the land of Edom, saying, 24 Aaron shall be gathered unto his people: for he shall not enter into the land which I have given unto the children of Israel, because ye rebelled against my word at the water of Meribah. 25 Take Aaron and Eleazar his son, and bring them up unto mount Hor: 26 And strip Aaron of his garments, and put them upon Eleazar his son: and Aaron shall be gathered *unto his people*, and shall die there. 27 And Moses did as the LORD commanded: and they went up into mount Hor in the sight of all the congregation. 28 And Moses stripped Aaron of his garments, and put them upon Eleazar his son; and Aaron died there in the top of the mount: and Moses and Eleazar came down from the mount. 29 And when all the congregation saw that Aaron was dead, they mourned for Aaron thirty days, *even* all the house of Israel.

--**KJV Genesis 15:18** In the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates:

--**KJV Deuteronomy 1:7** Turn you, and take your journey, and go to the mount of the Amorites, and unto all *the places* nigh thereunto, in the plain, in the hills, and in the vale, and in the south, and by the sea side, to the land of the Canaanites, and unto Lebanon, unto the great river, the river Euphrates.

**KJV Numbers 34:13** And Moses commanded the children of Israel, saying, This is the land which ye shall inherit by lot, which the LORD commanded to give unto the nine tribes, and to the half tribe: 14 For the tribe of the children of Reuben according to the house of their fathers, and the tribe of the children of Gad according to the house of their fathers, have received *their inheritance*; and half the tribe of Manasseh have received their inheritance: 15 The two tribes and the half tribe have received their inheritance on this side Jordan *near* Jericho eastward, toward the sunrising.

**KJV Numbers 34:16** And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 17 These *are* the names of the men which shall divide the land unto you: Eleazar the priest, and Joshua the son of Nun. 18 And ye shall take one prince of every tribe, to divide the land by inheritance. 19 And the names of the men *are* these: Of the tribe of Judah, Caleb the son of Jephunneh. 20 And of the tribe of the children of Simeon, Shemuel the son of Ammihud. 21 Of the tribe of Benjamin, Elidad the son of Chislon. 22 And the prince of the tribe of the

children of Dan, Bukki the son of Jogli. 23 The prince of the children of Joseph, for the tribe of the children of Manasseh, Hanniel the son of Ephod. 24 And the prince of the tribe of the children of Ephraim, Kemuel the son of Shiptan. 25 And the prince of the tribe of the children of Zebulun, Elizaphan the son of Parnach. 26 And the prince of the tribe of the children of Issachar, Paltiel the son of Azzan. 27 And the prince of the tribe of the children of Asher, Ahihud the son of Shelomi. 28 And the prince of the tribe of the children of Naphtali, Pedahel the son of Ammihud. 29 These are they whom the LORD commanded to divide the inheritance unto the children of Israel in the land of Canaan.

**KJV Numbers 35:1** And the LORD spake unto Moses in the plains of Moab by Jordan *near* Jericho, saying, 2 Command the children of Israel, that they give unto the Levites of the inheritance of their possession cities to dwell in; and ye shall give *also* unto the Levites suburbs for the cities round about them. 3 And the cities shall they have to dwell in; and the suburbs of them shall be for their cattle, and for their goods, and for all their beasts. 4 And the suburbs of the cities, which ye shall give unto the Levites, shall reach from the wall of the city and outward a thousand cubits round about. 5 And ye shall measure from without the city on the east side two thousand cubits, and on the south side two thousand cubits, and on the west side two thousand cubits, and on the north side two thousand cubits; and the city *shall be* in the midst: this shall be to them the suburbs of the cities. 6 And among the cities which ye shall give unto the Levites *there shall be* **six cities for refuge, which ye shall appoint for the manslayer, that he may flee thither: and to them ye shall add forty and two cities.** 7 So all the cities which ye shall give to the Levites *shall be* forty and eight cities: them *shall ye give* with their suburbs. 8 And the cities which ye shall give *shall be* of the possession of the children of Israel: from *them that have* many ye shall give many; but from *them that have* few ye shall give few: every one shall give of his cities unto the Levites according to his inheritance which he inheriteth.

--**KJV Deuteronomy 4:43** *Namely,* Bezer in the wilderness, in the plain country, of the Reubenites; and Ramoth in Gilead, of the Gadites; and Golan in Bashan, of the Manassites.

--**KJV Joshua 21:11** And they gave them the city of Arba the father of Anak, which *city is* Hebron, in the hill *country* of Judah, with the suburbs thereof round about it. 12 But the fields of the city, and the villages thereof, gave they to Caleb the son of Jephunneh for his possession. 13 Thus they gave to the children of Aaron the priest Hebron with her suburbs, *to be* a city of refuge for the slayer; and Libnah with her suburbs, 14 And Jattir with her suburbs, and Eshtemoa with her suburbs, 15 And Holon with her suburbs, and Debir with her suburbs, 16 And Ain with her suburbs, and Juttah with her suburbs, *and* Bethshemesh with her suburbs; nine cities out of those two tribes. 17 And out of the tribe of Benjamin, Gibeon with her suburbs, Geba with her suburbs, 18 Anathoth with her suburbs, and Almon with her suburbs; four cities. 19 All the cities of the children of Aaron, the priests, *were* thirteen cities with their suburbs. 20 And the families of the children of Kohath, the Levites which remained of the children of Kohath, even they had the cities of their lot out of the tribe of Ephraim. 21 For they gave them Shechem with her suburbs in mount Ephraim, *to be* a city of refuge for the slayer; and Gezer with her suburbs, 22 And Kibzaim with her suburbs, and Bethhoron with her suburbs; four cities. 23 And out of the tribe of Dan, Eltekeh with her suburbs, Gibbethon with her suburbs, 24 Aijalon with her suburbs, Gathrimmon with her suburbs; four cities. 25 And out of the half tribe of Manasseh, Tanach with her suburbs, and Gathrimmon with her suburbs; two cities. 26 All the cities *were* ten with their suburbs for the families of the children of Kohath that remained. 27 And unto the children of Gershon, of the families of the Levites, out of the *other* half tribe of Manasseh *they gave* Golan in Bashan with her suburbs, *to be* a city of refuge for the slayer; and Beeshterah with her suburbs; two cities. 28 And out of the tribe of Issachar, Kishon with her suburbs, Dabareh with her suburbs, 29 Jarmuth with her suburbs, Engannim with her suburbs; four cities. 30 And out of the tribe of Asher, Mishal with her suburbs, Abdon with her suburbs, 31 Helkath with her suburbs, and Rehob with her suburbs; four cities. 32 And out of the tribe of Naphtali, Kedesh in Galilee with her suburbs, *to be* a city of refuge for the slayer; and Hammothdor with her suburbs, and Kartan with her suburbs; three cities. 33 All the cities of the Gershonites according to their families *were* thirteen cities with their suburbs. 34 And unto the families of the children of Merari, the rest of the Levites, out of the tribe of Zebulun, Jokneam with her suburbs, and Kartah with her suburbs, 35 Dimnah with her suburbs, Nahalal with her suburbs; four cities. 36 And out of the tribe of Reuben, Bezer with her suburbs, and Jahazah with her suburbs, 37 Kedemoth with her suburbs, and Mephaath with her suburbs; four cities. 38 And out of the tribe of Gad, Ramoth in Gilead with her suburbs, *to be* a city of refuge for the slayer; and Mahanaim with her suburbs, 39 Heshbon with her suburbs, Jazer with her suburbs; four cities in all. 40 So all the cities for the children of Merari by their

families, which were remaining of the families of the Levites, were *by* their lot twelve cities.

--**KJV Numbers 26:54** To many thou shalt give the more inheritance, and to few thou shalt give the less inheritance: to every one shall his inheritance be given according to those that were numbered of him.

--**KJV Joshua 21:20** And the families of the children of Kohath, the Levites which remained of the children of Kohath, even they had the cities of their lot out of the tribe of Ephraim. 21 For they gave them Shechem with her suburbs in mount Ephraim, *to be* a city of refuge for the slayer; and Gezer with her suburbs, 22 And Kibzaim with her suburbs, and Bethhoron with her suburbs; four cities.

--**KJV Numbers 26:37** These *are* the families of the sons of Ephraim according to those that were numbered of them, thirty and two thousand and five hundred. These *are* the sons of Joseph after their families.

----**KJV Numbers 26:43** All the families of the Shuhamites, according to those that were numbered of them, *were* threescore and four thousand and four hundred.

**KJV Numbers 35:9** And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 10 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come over Jordan into the land of Canaan; 11 **Then ye shall appoint you cities to be cities of refuge for you; that the slayer may flee thither, which killeth any person at unawares.**

12 And they shall be unto you cities for refuge from the avenger; that the manslayer die not, until he stand before the congregation in judgment. 13 And of these cities which ye shall give six cities shall ye have for refuge. 14 Ye shall give three cities on this side Jordan, and three cities shall ye give in the land of Canaan, which shall be cities of refuge. 15 These six cities shall be a refuge, *both* for the children of Israel, and for the stranger, and for the sojourner among them: that every one that killeth any person unawares may flee thither.

**KJV Numbers 35:16** And if he smite him with an instrument of iron, so that he die, he is a murderer: the murderer shall surely be put to death. 17 And if he smite him with throwing a stone, wherewith he may die, and he die, he is a murderer: the murderer shall surely be put to death. 18 Or if he smite him with an hand weapon of wood, wherewith he may die, and he die, he is a murderer: the murderer shall surely be put to death. 19 **The revenger of blood himself shall slay the murderer: when he meeteth him, he shall slay him.** 20 But if he thrust him of hatred, or hurl at him by laying of wait, that he die; 21 Or in enmity smite him with his hand, that he die: he that smote him shall surely be put to death: for he is a murderer: the revenger of blood shall slay the murderer, when he meeteth him.

--**KJV Deuteronomy 17:7** The hands of the witnesses shall be first upon him to put him to death, and afterward the hands of all the people. So thou shalt put the evil away from among you.

--**KJV Deuteronomy 19:6** Lest the avenger of the blood pursue the slayer, while his heart is hot, and overtake him, because the way is long, and slay him; whereas he *was* not worthy of death, inasmuch as he hated him not in time past.

**KJV Numbers 35:22** But if he thrust him suddenly without enmity, or have cast upon him any thing without laying of wait, 23 Or with any stone, wherewith a man may die, seeing *him* not, and cast *it* upon him, that he die, and *was* not his enemy, neither sought his harm: 24 Then the congregation shall judge between the slayer and the revenger of blood according to these judgments: 25 And the congregation shall deliver the slayer out of the hand of the revenger of blood, and the congregation shall restore him to the city of his refuge, whither he was fled: and he shall abide in it unto the death of the high priest, which was anointed with the holy oil. 26 But if the slayer shall at any time come without the border of the city of his refuge, whither he was fled; 27 And the revenger of blood find him without the borders of the city of his refuge, and the revenger of blood kill the slayer; he shall not be guilty of blood: 28 Because he should have remained in the city of his refuge until the death of the high priest: but after the death of the high priest the slayer shall return into the land of his possession.

**KJV Numbers 35:29** So these things shall be for a statute of judgment unto you throughout your generations in all your dwellings. 30 Whoso killeth any person, the murderer shall be put to death by the mouth of witnesses: but one witness shall not testify against any person to cause him to die.

**KJV Numbers 35:31** Moreover ye shall take no satisfaction for the life of a murderer, which is guilty of death: but he shall be surely put to death. 32 And ye shall take no satisfaction for him that is fled to the city of his refuge, that he should come again to dwell in the land, until the death of the priest. 33 So ye shall not pollute the land wherein ye are: for blood it defileth the land: and the land cannot be cleansed of the blood that is shed therein, but by the blood of him that shed it. 34 Defile not therefore the land which ye shall inhabit, wherein I dwell: for I the LORD dwell among the children of Israel.

--**KJV Exodus 21:29** But if the ox were wont to push with his horn in time past, and it hath been testified

to his owner, and he hath not kept him in, but that he hath killed a man or a woman; the ox shall be stoned, and his owner also shall be put to death. 30 If there be laid on him a sum of money, then he shall give for the ransom of his life whatsoever is laid upon him.

--**KJV Deuteronomy 28:38** Thou shalt carry much seed out into the field, and shalt gather *but* little in; for the locust shall consume it.

--**KJV Leviticus 16:16** And he shall make an atonement for the holy *place*, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their transgressions in all their sins: and so shall he do for the tabernacle of the congregation, that remaineth among them in the midst of their uncleanness.

**KJV Numbers 36:1** And the chief fathers of the families of the children of Gilead, the son of Machir, the son of Manasseh, of the families of the sons of Joseph, came near, and spake before Moses, and before the princes, the chief fathers of the children of Israel: 2 And they said, The LORD commanded my lord to give the land for an inheritance by lot to the children of Israel: and my lord was commanded by the LORD to give the inheritance of Zelophehad our brother unto his daughters. 3 And if they be married to any of the sons of the *other* tribes of the children of Israel, then shall their inheritance be taken from the inheritance of our fathers, and shall be put to the inheritance of the tribe whereunto they are received: so shall it be taken from the lot of our inheritance. 4 And when the jubile of the children of Israel shall be, then shall their inheritance be put unto the inheritance of the tribe whereunto they are received: so shall their inheritance be taken away from the inheritance of the tribe of our fathers.

--**KJV Leviticus 26:14** But if ye will not hearken unto me, and will not do all these commandments; 15 And if ye shall despise my statutes, or if your soul abhor my judgments, so that ye will not do all my commandments, *but* that ye break my covenant: 16 I also will do this unto you; I will even appoint over you terror, consumption, and the burning ague, that shall consume the eyes, and cause sorrow of heart: and ye shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it.... 25 And I will bring a sword upon you, that shall avenge the quarrel of *my* covenant: and when ye are gathered together within your cities, I will send the pestilence among you; and ye shall be delivered into the hand of the enemy. 26 *And* when I have broken the staff of your bread, ten women shall bake your bread in one oven, and they shall deliver *you* your bread again by weight: and ye shall eat, and not be satisfied. 27 And if ye will not for all this hearken unto me, but walk contrary unto me; 28 Then I will walk contrary unto you also in fury; and I, even I, will chastise you seven times for your sins.

**KJV Numbers 36:5** And Moses commanded the children of Israel according to the word of the LORD, saying, The tribe of the sons of Joseph hath said well. 6 This is the thing which the LORD doth command concerning the daughters of Zelophehad, saying, Let them marry to whom they think best: only to the family of the tribe of their father shall they marry. 7 So shall not the inheritance of the children of Israel remove from tribe to tribe: for every one of the children of Israel shall keep himself to the inheritance of the tribe of his fathers. 8 And every daughter, that possesseth an inheritance in any tribe of the children of Israel, shall be wife unto one of the family of the tribe of her father, that the children of Israel may enjoy every man the inheritance of his fathers. 9 Neither shall the inheritance remove from one tribe to another tribe; but every one of the tribes of the children of Israel shall keep himself to his own inheritance.

**KJV Numbers 36:10** Even as the LORD commanded Moses, so did the daughters of Zelophehad: 11 For Mahlah, Tirzah, and Hoglah, and Milcah, and Noah, the daughters of Zelophehad, were married unto their father's brothers' sons: 12 *And* they were married into the families of the sons of Manasseh the son of Joseph, and their inheritance remained in the tribe of the family of their father.

--**KJV Numbers 27:1** Then came the daughters of Zelophehad, the son of Hopher, the son of Gilead, the son of Machir, the son of Manasseh, of the families of Manasseh the son of Joseph: and these *are* the names of his daughters; Mahlah, Noah, and Hoglah, and Milcah, and Tirzah.

**KJV Numbers 36:13** These *are* the commandments and the judgments, which the LORD commanded by the hand of Moses unto the children of Israel in the plains of Moab by Jordan *near* Jericho.
