Parshat: VEZOTH HA-BERACHAH (Deuteronomy 33:1 - 34:12)**Tanach - Deuteronomy Chapter 33**

1. And this is the blessing, with which Moses the man of God blessed the people of Israel before his death.
2. (K) And he said, The Lord came from Sinai, and rose up from Seir to them; he shone forth from Mount Paran, and he came with holy tens of thousands; from his right hand went a fiery law for them.
3. He truly loves the people; all his holy ones are in your hand; and they sat down at your feet; every one shall receive of your words.
4. Moses commanded us a Torah, the inheritance of the congregation of Jacob.
5. And he was king in Jeshurun, when the heads of the people and the tribes of Israel were gathered together.
6. Let Reuben live, and not die; and let not his men be few.
7. And this is the blessing of Judah; and he said, Hear, Lord, the voice of Judah, and bring him to his people; let his hands be sufficient for him; and be you a help to him from his enemies.
8. And of Levi he said, Let your Thummim and your Urim be with your pious one, whom you did test at Massah, and with whom you fought at the waters of Meribah;
9. Who said to his father and to his mother, I have not seen him; nor did he acknowledge his brothers, nor knew his own children; for they have observed your word, and kept your covenant.
10. They shall teach Jacob your judgments, and Israel your Torah; they shall put incense before you, and whole burnt sacrifice upon your altar.
11. Bless, Lord, his substance, and accept the work of his hands; strike through the loins of those who rise against him, and of those who hate him, that they rise not again.
12. And of Benjamin he said, The beloved of the Lord shall live in safety by him; and the Lord shall cover him all the day long, and he shall live between his shoulders.
13. And of Joseph he said, Blessed of the Lord be his land, for the precious things of heaven, for the dew, and for the deep that couches beneath,
14. And for the precious fruits brought forth by the sun, and for the precious things put forth by the moon,
15. And for the chief things of the ancient mountains, and for the precious things of the lasting hills,
16. And for the precious things of the earth and its fullness, and for the good will of him who lived in the bush; let the blessing come upon the head of Joseph, and upon the top of the head of him who was separated from his brothers.
17. The firstling of his herd, grandeur is his, and his horns are like the horns of a wild ox; with them he shall push the people together to the ends of the earth; and they are the ten thousands of Ephraim, and they are the thousands of Manasseh.
18. And of Zebulun he said, Rejoice, Zebulun, in your going out; and, Issachar, in your tents.
19. They shall call the people to the mountain; there they shall offer sacrifices of righteousness; for they shall suck of the abundance of the seas, and of treasures hidden in the sand.
20. And of Gad he said, Blessed be he who enlarges Gad; he lives as a lion, and tears the arm with the crown of the head.
21. And he provided the first part for himself, because there, in a portion of the lawgiver, was he seated; and he came with the heads of the people, he executed the justice of the Lord, and his judgments with Israel.
22. And of Dan he said, Dan is a lion's cub; he shall leap from Bashan.
23. And of Naphtali he said, O Naphtali, satisfied with favor, and full with the blessing of the Lord; possess you the west and the south.
24. And of Asher he said, Let Asher be blessed with children; let him be acceptable to his brothers, and let him dip his foot in oil.
25. Your shoes shall be iron and bronze; and as your days, so shall your strength be.
26. There is none like the God of Jeshurun, who rides upon the heaven in your help, and in his excellency on the sky.
27. The eternal God is your dwelling place, and underneath are the everlasting arms; and he shall thrust out the enemy from before you; and shall say, Destroy them.
28. Israel then shall live in safety alone; the fountain of Jacob shall be upon a land of grain and wine; also his heavens shall drop down dew.

29. Happy are you, O Israel; who is like you, O people saved by the Lord, the shield of your help, and who is the sword of your excellency! and your enemies shall submit themselves to you; and you shall tread upon their high places.

Tanach - Deuteronomy Chapter 34

1. And Moses went up from the plains of Moab to the Mountain of Nebo, to the top of Pisgah, that is opposite Jericho. And the Lord showed him all the land of Gilead, to Dan,
2. And all Naphtali, and the land of Ephraim, and Manasseh, and all the land of Judah, as far as the utmost sea,
3. And the Negev, and the plain of the valley of Jericho, the city of palm trees, as far as Zoar.
4. And the Lord said to him, This is the land which I swore to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, saying, I will give it to your seed; I have made you see it with your eyes, but you shall not go over there.
5. So Moses the servant of the Lord died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the Lord.
6. And he buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, opposite Beth-Peor; but no man knows his grave till this day.
7. And Moses was one hundred and twenty years old when he died; his eye was not dim, nor his natural force abated.
8. And the people of Israel wept for Moses in the plains of Moab thirty days; and the days of weeping and mourning for Moses were ended.
9. And Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom; for Moses had laid his hands upon him; and the people of Israel listened to him, and did as the Lord commanded Moses.
10. And there has not arisen since in Israel a prophet like Moses, whom the Lord knew face to face,
11. In all the signs and the wonders, which the Lord sent him to do in the land of Egypt to Pharaoh, and to all his servants, and to all his land,
12. And in all that mighty hand, and in all the great and awesome deeds which Moses performed in the sight of all Israel.

Haftorah: (VEZOTH HA-BERACHAH) Joshua 1:1-18

12. And to the Reubenites, and to the Gadites, and to the half tribe of Manasseh, spoke Joshua, saying,
13. Remember the word which Moses the servant of the Lord commanded you, saying, The Lord your God has given you rest, and has given you this land.
14. Your wives, your little ones, and your cattle, shall remain in the land which Moses gave you on this side of the Jordan; but you shall pass armed before your brothers, all the mighty men of valor, and help them;

15. When the Lord should give your brothers rest, as he has given you, and when they also shall possess the land which the Lord your God gives them; then you shall return to the land of your possession, and enjoy it, which Moses the Lord's servant gave you on this side of the Jordan toward the sunrise.

16. And they answered Joshua, saying, All that you command us we will do, and wherever you send us, we will go.

17. As we listened to Moses in all things, so will we listen to you; only the Lord your God be with you, as he was with Moses.

18. If any rebels against your commandment, and will not listen to your words in all that you command him, he shall be put to death; only be strong and courageous.

When the Lord should give your brothers rest, as he has given you, and when they also shall possess the land which the Lord your God gives them; then you shall return to the land of your possession, and enjoy it, which Moses the Lord's servant gave you on this side of the Jordan toward the sunrise.

16. And they answered Joshua, saying, All that you command us we will do, and wherever you send us, we will go.

17. As we listened to Moses in all things, so will we listen to you; only the Lord your God be with you, as he was with Moses.

18. **If any rebels against your commandment, and will not listen to your words in all that you command him, he shall be put to death;** only be strong and courageous.

--**KJV Joshua 14:6** Then the children of Judah came unto Joshua in Gilgal: and Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenezite said unto him, Thou knowest the thing that the LORD said unto **Moses the man of God** concerning me and thee in Kadeshbarnea.

--**KJV Psalm 90:1** {A Prayer of **Moses the man of God**.} Lord, thou hast been our dwelling place in all generations.

--**KJV Genesis 48:20** And he blessed them that day, saying, In thee shall Israel bless, saying, God make thee as Ephraim and as Manasseh: and he set Ephraim before Manasseh.

KJV Deuteronomy 33:29 Happy *art* thou, O Israel: ***who is like unto thee, O people saved by the LORD, the shield of thy help, and who is the sword of thy excellency! and thine enemies shall be found liars unto thee; and thou shalt tread upon their high places.***

--**KJV Joshua 10:24** And it came to pass, when they brought out those kings unto Joshua, that Joshua called for all the men of Israel, and said unto the captains of the men of war which went with him, Come near, put your feet upon the necks of these kings. --**KJV Judges 18:30** And the children of Dan set up the graven image: and Jonathan, the son of Gershom, the son of Manasseh, he and his sons were priests to the tribe of Dan until the day of the captivity of the land.

--**KJV Deuteronomy 11:24** Every place whereon the soles of your feet shall tread shall be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the river Euphrates, even unto the uttermost sea shall your coast be.
